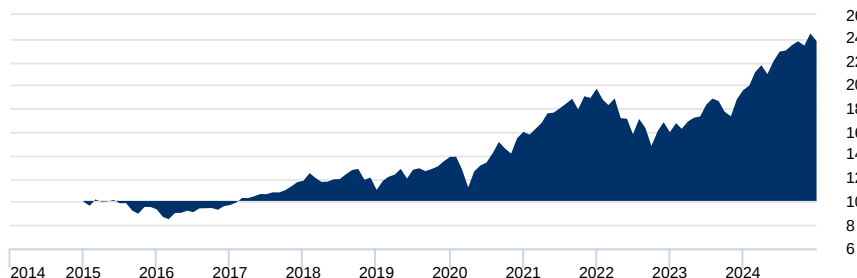

100% S&P 500 Total Return Index (hedged to C\$)

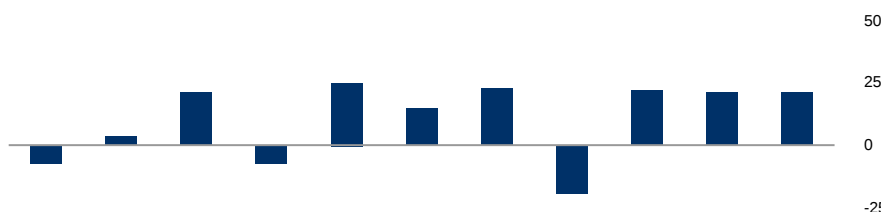
Performance analysis for Series A as of December 31, 2024

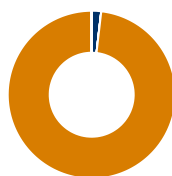
